RICHMOND CITY BASEBALL ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

The Richmond City Baseball Association (RCBA) Awards program assists students in transition from secondary school to college/university. The purpose of these awards is to support academically qualified students who show an interest in pursuing a post-secondary education. The scholarships are awarded primarily for achievement in areas such as academic, leadership, community service, artistic endeavours and athletics.

The awards are open to students who will successfully complete the requirements for high school in British Columbia and are applying to attend a post-secondary institution.

<u>Value</u>

The RCBA awards are offered in denominations of \$500 to \$1000 up to a maximum of **\$5000** annually.

Who Should Apply?

Applicants must meet the following eligibility criteria:

- 1. A Canadian citizen or permanent resident graduating from a British Columbia secondary school who must have applied to or is planning to attend a post-secondary institution.
- 2. Students who have demonstrated academic and leadership achievements in community, athletics and school.
- 3. Students should have a minimum GPA of 3.0 or B average.

4. Must be a registered player within the current year of application.

The application requires a nomination letter from someone who is well-acquainted with you and who can comment on your character, academic qualifications, and leadership. These individuals may include – but are not limited to – coaches, teachers, counselors, principals, supervisors from work and volunteer positions, and/or community or religious leaders.

Deadline

The deadline to apply for this award is May 31st in the current year

How Do I Apply?

Students in their final year of high school are eligible to apply for the award. To apply, the candidate must complete the **RCBA Scholarship Application Form,** provide a certified copy of their high school transcript, and a nomination letter.

The RCBA reserves the right to decide if any or all the awards will be disbursed in any given year.
